MENS DIVISIONS:	Open, A, Commercial, Rec I, Rec II (Divisions may be combined due to low entries.)
WOMEN'S DIVISIONS:	Open, Commercial, Recreation (Divisions may be combined due to low entries.)
GENERAL RESTRICTIONS:	<p>~ Players are only allowed to compete on one roster in the tournament.</p> <p>~ Any current or graduating college player (subject to NCAA and NAIA rules) may participate in the Open division. Open is the only division available to college players who played college basketball during the 2019-20 season. Players are responsible for confirming with their coach whether or not their participation in the Grand Am tournament will affect their eligibility.</p> <p>~ Teams with three or more former college players must play in the Open or A division.</p> <p><b><i>~No former college players are permitted to play in any Recreation division. This includes red-shirted players and players who participated or practiced as part of the team for even a single day. Former junior college players of every level are considered college players and therefore cannot participate in any Recreation division. Teams with three or more former college players must play in the Open or A division. Former Division I players must play in the Open division. Division II players may play in the Open or A division.</i></b></p> <p>~ Women's teams with three or more current/former college players must play in the Open division. Former junior college players or players who competed on a junior varsity count as former college players.</p> <p>~ Women's teams with any current/former Division I or Division II players must play in the Open division.</p> <p>~ No high school players (underclassmen or graduating seniors) are allowed due to compete in the tournament due to NCAA rules and regulations.</p> <p>~ All current or former professional players must compete in the Open division.</p> <p>~ Teams found with illegal players will forfeit the game.</p>
REGISTRATION & FEES:	<p>Completed registration and rosters must be submitted by the entry deadline. In the interest of fair play and to complete divisions, we reserve the right to reclassify teams prior to the tournament.</p> <p>Rosters submitted online by Feb. 28, 2020 .....\$235 U.S. Funds (2-game guarantee)</p> <p>Rosters submitted online after Feb. 28, 2020.....\$260 U.S. Funds (2-game guarantee)</p> <p><b>No entries will be accepted after 10 p.m. on March 11, 2020 unless more teams are needed to fill a division.</b></p> <p><i>All entry forms must include payment <u>in full</u>.
